The program is designed for those interested in career exploration or who have a goal of paid employment. During the program, participants will engage in hands-on learning and develop skills relating to employment.

PROGRAM APPLICANTS MUST BE WILLING TO:

Select an employment industry and develop a career plan

OR

Identify an employment goal, be willing to work 12-15 hours each week, and search/accept paid employment in the community

- Enhance social and communication skills in the workplace.
- Learn skills to seek volunteer experiences and/or paid employment upon completion of the program
